# President's Message

Dear DGC fellow members – of rants and raves

If you have been out to the Club lately, you have experienced several things that may have had you give rave reviews. We get dozens of compliments about events, the atmosphere, the food, the service. New members, who attended the new member social, raved about how friendly people are here and how they have been welcomed. Visitors to the course, who have played in many places, rave about our fantastic greens and how beautiful the course is.

Merriam Webster - “rant”: to complain loudly, angrily, or unreasonably, to talk or recite in a noisy, excited, or bombastic manner. If you have been out to the Club lately, you may have encountered some rants. Thankfully we have an environment where the rave/rant ratio is high, so maybe you have not. But the bad thing is that rants can very quickly have a large negative impact. Rants are never helpful, even if they have a legitimate basis. In addition, they often are not based on facts, and they rile up people unnecessarily and take much work to undo.

You may or may not know why I am writing about this (and I hope that you are a “raver” rather than a “ranter”). My hope is that most of you reading this have not heard any of the rants. Unfortunately, there will be some of you that have which indicates that we have an opportunity for improvement. Let’s create an environment where we assume positive intentions, thank people for volunteering or doing their job, have patience and grace if things are not perfect. If you hear about something that seems off, refer the person to someone who will have the facts, or talk to them yourself. Ask staff, ask a board member. We like “concerned citizens” and if you bring a legitimate concern to the table, I promise it will be met with a listening ear. I personally get several calls or text messages or emails monthly. Most of the time I will thank the person, explain the

situation (which usually already satisfies the member) and if necessary, make sure the situation is corrected if possible, or goes on the list if not immediately possible. I know other board members do the same.

Here are a few updates: 1) the pool committee was fully staffed and opened up the pool nicely on time 2) a committee has been working on a plan to address the ongoing sprinkler situation (thank you member volunteers for jumping in with us). To be specific: we are not withholding water for any reason and definitely not due to any budgetary constraints. I seriously do not know where some of this “information” comes from, but it falls in the rant category and is without foundation and is not helpful. 3) the tournament golfers may have noticed the Golf Buddy Pro app which makes the pro-shop’s life easier and streamlines everything. Yes, we are leveraging technology, and it is very cool and 4) we are aware of several other needs that are being addressed, some of them not so exciting, but very necessary. Think for instance of roofing problems. Reality is that with a Club the buildings and equipment need to be fixed regularly and replaced every so many years. Hopefully, you will not notice much about this, I just want to keep you informed.

And so, we continue to provide and improve on the “exceptional, private golf and country club lifestyle, through excellent service, premier recreational facilities and sensational social events in a family-friendly atmosphere” (you may recognize this as DGC’s Mission Statement). If you feel that there is an area where we do not, don’t rant but contact a board member. If you believe we do, then feel free to rave about it a little!

*Update*

The grass is growing and the birdies are dropping! We had the Kickoff Classic on April 29<sup>th</sup> and our course was in great shape. Huge thanks to Adam and crew for their hard work!

In addition to their normal duties, the theme for this month is "clean up, fix up, and paint up." You will see many cosmetic improvements around the course. In the past few weeks, they have added new flags and cups, pine straw, sod, completed limbing on #1, and removed downed limbs. This month new mulch will be put down, and they will continue to address the bare areas on #12 and #16. One pending project is to improve the pathway from #5 Senior/Ladies Tee to the course restrooms. We have looked at the site, and are considering options to provide better access while protecting the aesthetics of the golf course. We also have many dead trees that will need to be addressed.

The irrigation system continues to be a challenge, requiring much time and effort. Repairs have been made on 4 holes, and they are working to make repairs on #18 green and the practice green. We are seeing a few problem areas resulting from the snow/ice storms of February. Adam is addressing those.

We have Club members who are volunteering their time to assist our greens crew. It is incredibly helpful and greatly appreciated!

With limited staff and budget, our team continues to provide us with a great place to play golf and build friendships. My hope is that we all appreciate "who and what" we have at the Danville Golf Club!
